

## MORGAN COUNTY RECYCLE SITES

**MOORESVILLE:** Southbridge Crossing (Southeast corner adjacent to theater)

**MARTINSVILLE:** 160 N. Park Ave. (Near Morgan Co. Jail)

**PARAGON:** 300 N Main St. -- Adjacent to Paragon Town Hall

**MONROVIA:** 395 S Chestnut St (Highway 39 S) -- East edge of Monrovia Elementary School

**BROOKLYN:** 16 North Main St. (West side)

**MORGANTOWN:** 269 Highland St.

### **Materials Accepted:**

**PAPER:** newspapers, magazines, cardboard (please flatten), office paper

**GLASS:** clear, green, brown & beverage

**PLASTICS:** numbers 1-7 (except Styrofoam).

**Please empty your bags** to allow more material in a bin.

**Materials NOT Accepted:** Rubbish or trash; plastic bags; light bulbs; drinking glasses, window panes or mirrors; ceramics; motor oil and antifreeze containers; Styrofoam; liquids, furniture.

**E-cycling/Electronics:** As per Indiana Code 13-20.5, Indiana households, public schools, and small businesses can no longer mix unwanted electronics (computer monitors, computers, televisions, printers, keyboards and mice, DVD players, video cassette recorders, tablets, or fax machines) with municipal waste that is intended for disposal at a landfill or intended for disposal by burning or incineration.

**Packing Peanuts:** UPS Stores-(various locations)

**Paint:** Latex Paint can be disposed of by adding sand or kitty litter to the paint, stir & leave in dry, well-ventilated area to dry out. Once dried out-- dispose of it with regular trash. Leave lid off so hauler knows it's dry. Never dispose of paint still in liquid form. Oil based paints, stains, varnishes should never be disposed of with typical household waste. Bring to Tox-Away Events.
