

## **ORDINANCE 12-1973**

### **AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING AREA ON THE EAST AND WEST SIDE OF SOUTH INDIANA STREET FROM HARRISON STREET TO STATE ROAD 67 IN THE TOWN OF MOORESVILLE, MORGAN COUNTY, INDIANA**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Indiana, that:

By the powers vested in the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Indiana, by the Acts of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, it is hereby ordered and ordained that whereas it is necessary to control the flow of traffic in the Town of Mooresville, Morgan County, Indiana, by establishing a no parking zone on the East and West side of South Indiana Street, from Harrison Street to State Road 67, it is hereby ordered and ordained that an ordinance adopted prohibiting parking in said area on the East and West side of South Indiana Street.

Section I: Be it hereby ORDERED and ORDAINED that for the control of the flow of traffic in the Town of Mooresville, Morgan County, Indiana, that on the East and West sides or right of way of South Indiana from a point where Harrison Street intersects with said South Indiana Street to a point where South Indiana Street intersects with State Road 67, be, and hereby is established as a no parking zone and that no parking shall be permitted at any time at and along said area on the East or West side of South Indiana Street.

Section II: The Town Marshall, or any other person designated by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Morgan County, Indiana, shall post or cause to be posted appropriate signs at the aforesaid no parking area, designating such area as a “no parking zone”.

Section III: Violations of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor, punishable by fines of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).

Section IV: Be it further ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Indiana, that the Mooresville Town Marshall or any

deputy Marshall of the Town of Mooresville, are hereby authorized to remove and tow away or have removed and towed away by commercial towing service, any motor vehicle illegally parked in the designated area on South Indiana Street from Harrison Street to State Road 67.

That any such vehicle as shall be towed away for violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be towed to a place of safe storage and shall not be returned to the owner of such motor vehicle until such time as said owner pays a reasonable commercial towing charge and storage expense as may be determined under the circumstances; in addition thereto, such owner of said motor vehicle shall pay the stated fine assessed for the parking violation as provided in Section III herein.

Section V: Whereas an emergency exists, this ordinance is declared to be in full force and effect upon passage of same and the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to publish said ordinance for two (2) consecutive weeks.

Said Ordinance ADOPTED this 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 1973.
