

ORDINANCE 14-1973

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RESTRICTIVE SPEED LIMITS ON CARLISLE STREET FROM STATE ROAD 267 TO INDIANA STREET AND ON INDIANA STREET FROM A POINT WHEREIN THE SAME INTERSECTS WITH CARLISLE STREET, NORTH TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF MOORESVILLE, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Indiana, that:

By the powers vested in the said Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Morgan County, Indiana, by the Acts of the State of Indiana (1973, Public Law 84, Section 1, page 536), it is hereby Ordered and Ordained that as a result of a traffic investigation the maximum speed limit of thirty miles per hour (30 MPH) is greater than reasonable and safe under the conditions found to exist on Carlisle Street from State Road 267 East to Indiana Street and on Indiana Street from a point wherein the same intersections with Carlisle Street from State Road 267 East to Indiana Street and on Indiana Street from a point wherein the same intersections with Carlisle Street, North to the Mooresville Town Corporate Limits by reason of the presence of school children in said area at various times during the day and night. It is hereby Ordered and Ordained that an ordinance be adopted restricting the maximum speed limit thirty miles per hour (30 MPH) to a speed limit of twenty miles per hour (20 MPH) on said streets which are within the immediate vicinity of a public school.

Section I:

Be it hereby ORDERED AND ORDAINED for the control of traffic and for the safety and welfare of school children on Carlisle Street from State Road 267, East to Indiana Street and on Indiana Street from a point wherein said street intersects with Carlisle Street, North to the corporate limits of the Town of Mooresville, Indiana, that the maximum speed limit permitted by statute, the same being thirty miles per hour (30 MPH), shall be altered to a reduced speed limit of twenty miles per hour (20 MPH) on said streets at all times when children are present.

Section II:

The Town Marshall, or any other person designated by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Indiana, shall post or cause to be posted appropriate signs at and along said streets setting forth the altered speed limit of twenty miles per hour (20 MPH) for all motor vehicles using said streets during the time that school children are present.

Section III:

Violations of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor punishable by fines of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) or more than Twenty-Five (\$25.00).

Section IV:

Whereas an emergency exists, said ordinance is declared to be in full force and effect on passage of same and the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to publish said ordinance for two (2) consecutive weeks.

Said ordinance passed and adopted this 6th day of November, 1973.
