

ORDINANCE 17-1982

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING AREA ON THE SOUTH RIGHT-OF-WAY OF SHERWOOD DRIVE FOR A DISTANCE OF 30 FEET WEST OF THE INTERSECTION OF INDIANAPOLIS ROAD WITH SWEETWOOD DRIVE IN TOWN OF MOORESVILLE, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Indiana, that:

By the powers vested in the Board of Trustees of the Civil Town of Mooresville, Indiana, by Indiana Code 9-4-1-28, it is hereby ORDERED AND ORDAINED that whereas it is necessary to control the flow of traffic in the Town of Mooresville, Indiana, on Sweetwood Drive, beginning at a point on the Southwest corner of the intersection of Sweetwood Drive and Indianapolis Road, and thence running 30 feet West on and along the South right-of-way of Sweetwood Drive, it is hereby ORDERED AND ORDAINED that an ordinance be adopted prohibiting parking on and along said designated area at all times.

Section 1:

BE IT HEREBY ORDERED for the control of traffic on the South right-of-way of Sweetwood Drive, beginning at a point on the Southwest corner of the intersection of Sweetwood Drive and Indianapolis Road, thence running 30 feet West on and along the south right-of-way of Sweetwood Drive, be, and hereby is, established as a “No Parking Zone”, and that no parking shall be permitted at any time at and along said designated area.

Section 2:

The Town Marshall, or any other person designated by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Mooresville, Morgan County, Indiana shall post or cause to be posted appropriate signs at the aforesaid no parking area, designating such area as a “no parking zone”.

Section 3:

Be it further Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Civil Town of Mooresville, Morgan County, Indiana, that the Mooresville Town Marshal or any Deputy Marshal of the Civil Town of Mooresville, Indiana, is hereby authorized to tow away, or have removed and towed away by commercial towing service, any motor vehicle illegally parked in the above designated areas on the rights-of-way of the streets described in Section I.

That any such vehicle towed away for violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be towed to a place of safe storage and shall not be returned to the owner of such motor vehicle, until such time as the owner pays a reasonable commercial towing charge, and storage expense, if any, as may be determined under the circumstances; and in addition thereto, such owner of said vehicle shall pay such fines as shall be assessed for the parking violation as provided in Section 4.

Section 4:

Violation of this Ordinance is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor, punishable by fines of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Twenty-Five dollars (\$25.00).

Section 5:

Whereas, an emergency exists, this Ordinance is declared to be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby specifically repealed in whole or in part, and the Clerk-Treasurer is directed to publish said Ordinance for two (2) consecutive weeks.

Said ordinance passed and adopted this 21st day of December 1982.
