

ORDINANCE 9-2001

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NO PARKING AREAS ON JEFFERSON AND HARRISON STREETS

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted to the Civil Town of Mooresville through its Town Council to enact certain Ordinances to establish reasonable regulation for the protection of the life, health, safety and property of the citizens of the Town of Mooresville;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ORDAINED that an Ordinance be adopted prohibiting parking on the specified portions of Jefferson and Harrison Streets in the Town of Mooresville as more particularly set out herein:

Section I. It shall be posted and there shall be no parking on the east or west side of Jefferson Street from twenty-five feet (25') north or south of Broad Alley on the east and west side of Jefferson Street; no parking for twenty-five feet (25') from the intersection of Jefferson and Harrison Streets on the east side of Jefferson Street twenty-five (25') south of the southeast corner of Jefferson and Harrison Streets; no parking for twenty-five (25') east on Harrison Street from the southeast corner and the northeast corner of Jefferson and Harrison Streets on either side of Harrison Street; no parking on Harrison Street from twenty-five feet (25') west of the intersection of Jefferson and Harrison Streets; and, no parking on Jefferson Street on the east side from twenty-five feet (25') north of the intersection with Jefferson Street and Harrison Streets. These areas shall be established and posted, as a "no parking zone" and no parking shall be permitted at any time at or along said designated areas.

Section II. The Mooresville Street Department shall post these areas with signage to show that each area mentioned in Section I is designated a "no parking zone".

Section III. The Mooresville Police Department is hereby authorized to tow or have removed any vehicle parked in this area by a commercial towing service for any motor vehicle illegally parked in the above-designated areas on the rights-of-way of the streets designated in Section I may be ticketed with a violation of this offense. In the event the vehicle is

towed it shall be towed to a place of safe storage and shall not be returned to the owner of such motor vehicle until such time as owner pays a reasonable charge to the towing service along with the storage expense and other reasonable and in addition thereto said owner of the vehicle shall pay a fine assessed for the parking violation as provided in Section IV of this Ordinance.

Section IV. Violation of this Ordinance is hereby declared to be punishable by a fine of not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00)

Section V. This Ordinance is declared to be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby specifically repealed in whole or in part, and the Clerk-Treasurer shall publish said Ordinance as required by law.
